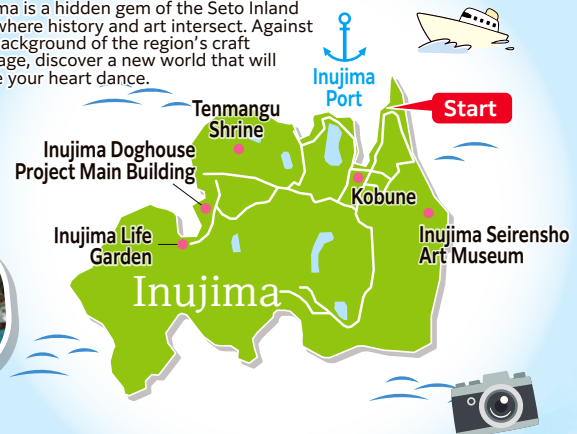
Inujima Seirensuo Art Museum

Guidance

※ We will be taking photos for recording and reporting as a monitor tour of Hyogo Prefecture. Please note that the photos taken may be posted on the Hyogo Prefectural Government website, etc., so please participate if you are aware of this. We also ask for your cooperation in completing the survey.

- ※ The questionnaire you filled out on the day will be provided to Hyogo Prefecture as data for this monitor tour, and will be used as reference material for future business plans. However, it will not be provided to any other third party.
- ※ The times for the published itinerary may change slightly depending on transportation agency schedule revisions, local road conditions and weather conditions. Please note.
- ※ The ship may rock depending on the weather. If you are concerned about seasickness, please take motion sickness medicine beforehand.

- ※ There is a toilet on board, but it may shake, so please use the restroom before boarding.
- ※ The sailing route may change depending on the weather and sea conditions on the day of sailing. If the tour is canceled due to stormy weather or other sea conditions, we will contact the representative before departure.
- ※ Please wear a helmet (free rental) when using Naoshima's electric rental bicycles.
- ※ Parking at Himeji Port cannot be reserved. If the toll parking lot is full, you may be unable to park. We ask for your cooperation in using public transit instead.
- ※ Will not be canceled for rain. Please bring a raincoat so you will be prepared.
- ※ Tour price does not include the cost of Setouchi Triennale 2025 admission passports.
- ※ Tour price does not include entry fees for paid viewing facilities (including Inujima Seirensho Art Museum and the Inujima "Art House Project").

<Terms and Conditions for Travel (Summary)> Please read carefully

Please ensure you receive and carefully read a copy of the full Terms and Conditions for Travel before applying.

● Travel arrangement services agreement for organized tours

This tour is planned and run by the Himeji Branch of JTB Corp. (100 Minami Ekimae-cho, Himeji-shi, Hyogo, Japan Tourism Agency Commissioner Registration No. 44, hereinafter "JTB"). Customers participating in this tour must conclude a travel arrangement services agreement for organized tours (hereinafter "Travel Arrangement Services Agreement") with JTB. The terms and conditions for travel are set forth below and in the separately provided full Terms and Conditions for Travel, the written confirmation known as the final itinerary that will be provided prior to departure, and our Travel Arrangement Services Agreement for Organized Tours General Terms and Conditions. A copy of our General Terms and Conditions will be provided upon request.

● Applications and establishment of agreements

- Apply by filling out the required details on a prescribed application form.
- A Travel Arrangement Services Agreement shall come into effect when JTB agrees to conclude an agreement and accepts your application fee.
- Application fee: Full amount of the cost of travel

● Payment of cost of travel

Please pay the cost of travel at least 13 days before the day immediately preceding your departure date (or by the date specified by JTB). If you have a credit card issued by a JTB affiliated credit card company, you may be permitted to pay the cost of travel, cancellation fees, and any additional expenses, etc. without your signature. In this case, the date of use of the card will be the date of your approval payment, unless you request otherwise.

● Cancellation Fees (for day trips)

If you cancel a Travel Arrangement Services Agreement for any reason after an agreement has been concluded, the amount shown below will be charged as a cancellation fee.

● Items included in cost of travel

- Fares and charges for transportation (economy class unless specified otherwise), meals, entrance and admission fees, and consumption tax and other taxes specified in each travel itinerary and guidance.
- Expenses for tour conductors on tours accompanied by conductors and gratuities necessary for group activities.
- Items indicated as being included in cost of travel in brochures, etc. In principle, these costs will not be refunded even if partly unused due to your circumstances.

● Items not included in cost of travel

- Items other than "items included in the cost of travel" above are not included in the cost of travel. Examples of items not included are listed below.
- Excess baggage charges (baggage exceeding a specific weight, capacity, or quantity).
 - Various expenses of a personal nature, such as cleaning charges, telecommunications charges, other additional food and beverages, and associated taxes and service charges.
 - Fees for optional tours (excursions for an additional fee).
 - Additional fares and charges imposed by transportation providers (example: fuel surcharge).
 - Transportation to/from your home to the departure/return location.

● Special compensation

Regardless of whether there is willful misconduct or negligence on the part of JTB or a person we have asked to make arrangements on our behalf, JTB will pay compensation or solatium within the following scope for certain damages incurred to your body, life or baggage due to a sudden and unforeseen accident while participating in an organized tour, based on the Special Compensation Regulations attached to the Terms and Conditions for Travel Arrangement Services for Organized Tours.

- Compensation for death: 15 million yen - Compensation for hospitalization: 20,000 to 200,000 yen
- Compensation for outpatient visits: 10,000 to 50,000 yen - Compensation for damage to personal belongings: 150,000 yen per person (limited to a maximum of 100,000 yen per item covered)

● Terms and conditions for travel for customers who wish to conclude a "telecommunications agreement"

If we receive an application from a holder of a credit card issued by a JTB affiliated credit card company (hereinafter "Member") on the condition of "receiving payment for the cost of travel and cancellation fees, etc. without the Member's signature" (hereinafter "Telecommunications Agreement"), the following points will differ from our standard terms and conditions for travel.

- A Travel Arrangement Services Agreement based on a Telecommunications Agreement shall come into effect when you receive notification that we agree to conclude a Travel Arrangement Services Agreement. We will ask you to notify us of your membership number and card expiration date, etc. when you apply.
- When a credit card cannot be used to make payment due to lack of available credit or other reasons, we shall terminate the credit card payment authorization agreement and charge a penalty equal to the stipulated cancellation fee. However, this does not apply in the event that payment for travel is made in cash by a deadline we separately specify.

● Enrollment in domestic travel insurance

If you are injured at the travel destination, you may be required to pay high medical and transportation expenses, etc. Moreover, in the event of an accident, claiming compensation for loss or damage or recovering compensation from the perpetrator is extremely difficult. We recommend that you enroll in adequate domestic travel insurance to cover such treatment costs, transportation costs, and death or residual disability. Please contact us for more details.

● Reporting accidents, etc.

If an accident occurs during travel, please immediately notify the tour conductor, local staff, transportation, accommodation or other travel service provider or the place where you applied for travel. (Please report the accident as soon as you can if you are unable to report the accident immediately.)

● Handling of personal information

(1) In addition to using personal information provided in the application form, etc. submitted when applying for travel to contact you, JTB and our sales agents will provide personal information received at the time of applying and personal data pertaining to flight information by transmitting such information in advance via electronic or other means, to transportation and accommodation providers, etc., insurance companies, government agencies and souvenir shops listed in the tour pamphlet and final itinerary, to the extent necessary to arrange the travel services you have applied for and procedures for receiving such services, to the extent necessary for the procedures for insurance to cover JTB's liability under the Travel Arrangement Services Agreement and expenses incurred in the event of an accident, etc., and to the extent necessary to enhance your shopping experience at souvenir shops, etc. at the destination.

(2) JTB and our sales agent may request personal information on an individual who is to serve as your emergency contact person during travel to be prepared in case you fall ill or are involved in an accident, etc. while travelling. Such personal information shall be used if we deem it necessary to contact the emergency contact person if you fall ill, etc. while travelling. You are responsible for obtaining the consent of your emergency contact person regarding the provision of his or her personal information to JTB and our sales agents.

(3) Please refer to the "Handling of Personal Information" section of the full Terms and Conditions for Travel regarding other handling of personal information.
